What We Offer:

We offer a range of age appropriate interventions and activities to help children and young people express their emotions and improve the way they deal with death to help give them increased resilience for the future.

Our therapeutic model is a child-centred and age-appropriate eclectic approach that is adapted to the needs of the bereaved child or young person. We offer a confidential and non-judgemental space to explore feelings of loss and grief in a safe and boundaried environment.

- A specialised bereavement support service for children aged 5-16 years
- An initial clinical assessment conducted by a qualified assessor with the child and/or parent
- An initial offer of 6-12 weekly sessions lasting 45-60 minutes held at the same time and place with the same support worker
- Sessions held at school or at our consulting rooms in central St Albans
- A safe, non-judgmental and non-discriminatory service



Your Support Worker:

- Is specially trained to work with bereaved children according to Bereavement Matters' model
- Abides by Bereavement Matters' Code of Ethics and Practice
- Undergoes an enhanced DBS check
- Receives regular supervision
- Receives on-going professional training



Who We Are:

Your Commitment:

- Be punctual for all appointments
- Attend agreed sessions regularly
- Give at least 24 hours' notice if unable to attend by calling 01727-841841 during office hours (Mondays-Thursdays from 9am to 1pm).
- Give notice for holidays
- Respect our volunteers



Our Self-Referral Fee Policy:

- Initial one-off clinical assessment is charged at £35 or £20 per session for those on limited means
- Weekly sessions are subsidised and charged at £35 or £20 per session for those on limited means
- You will be invoiced for these sessions
- Missed or cancelled sessions are chargeable in full, apart from exceptional circumstances (such as prolonged illness or hospital admissions) to enable a space to be reserved weekly
- The support worker's holidays or absences will not be charged



You can choose to make a referral via your child's school

When a referral is made through the child's school, the SCHOOL AGREES:

- To obtain parent/carer consent
- To provide an appropriate room for the pupil to be seen by the Support Worker for all of the agreed sessions
- To provide a member of staff to communicate with and make known the Safeguarding/Designated Senior Person for child protection concerns
- To inform Bereavement Matters in advance if the pupil is absent from school when a session has been planned
- To be invoiced at the end of the work
